

# PANRE Longitudinal Assessment®

## What is PANRE-LA®?

Board Certified PAs now have two options to meet the recertification exam requirement - the traditional **Physician Assistant National Recertifying Examination® (PANRE)** administered at proctored testing centers, and the **PANRE Longitudinal Assessment (PANRE-LA)®**. If you're wondering if PANRE-LA is for you, here are some key features to help inform your decision.

### Format

- Accessible on any compatible device.
- 25 questions each quarter with 5 minutes to answer each question.
- Online/print resources can be used to help answer questions.
- Content based on PANRE/PANRE-LA Blueprint.
- Immediate feedback after each question with explanation and references.

### Scoring

- Scale scores reflect the participant's performance and the relative difficulty of the questions they answer.
- The passing standard is not anchored to a specific raw score.
- Cumulative performance feedback provided quarterly.
- Final score uses the best 8 of 12 quarters.

### Learning

- Incorporates elements of adult learning and spaced education.
- 5 topics repeated each quarter to facilitate learning and reinforce existing knowledge.
- Earn Category 1 CME for each quarter completed.

## Feedback from the Longitudinal Assessment Pilot

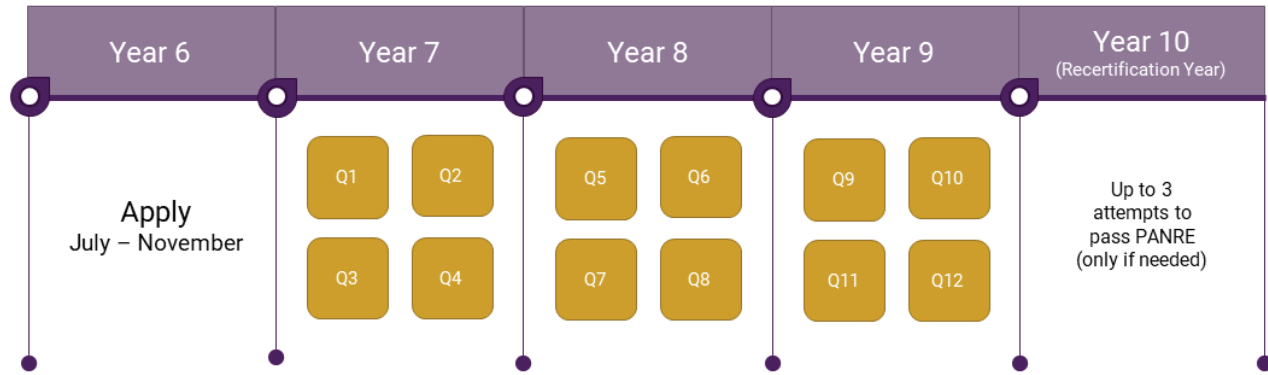
- 97.5% who completed the Pilot passed
- 97% said they would prefer it over the proctored exam
- 93% said it was not difficult to complete 25 questions per quarter
- 96% said it provided a learning experience

# PANRE Longitudinal Assessment<sup>®</sup> Process Timeline



## Eligibility

Board Certified PAs who want to participate in PANRE-LA must apply in the 6<sup>th</sup> year of their recertification cycle and start the exam in their 7<sup>th</sup> year.

PAs who do not successfully complete PANRE-LA will have a maximum of three opportunities to take and pass PANRE at a Pearson VUE test center.

## 2024 Application Information



Board Certified PAs who are due to recertify in 2028 are eligible to apply for PANRE-LA in 2024 the 6<sup>th</sup> year of their recertification cycle. The application window opens in July and closes Nov 30.

## Traditional PANRE

The traditional proctored PANRE will still be available for PAs who prefer this format or who do not successfully complete PANRE-LA. PANRE is available in the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> years of the recertification cycle. Both exams use the same blueprint and question format. The application fee for each exam is \$350.
