Any one of the groups that humans are often divided into based on physical traits




ETHNICITY

Ethnic – "of or relating to large groups of people classed according to common racial, national, tribal, religious, linguistic, or cultural origin or background"




GENETIC ANCESTRY




Information about the people that an individual is biologically descended from, including their genetic relationships


RACE ESSENTIALISM



Presidio of San Francisco, California May 10, 1942

INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL PERSONS OF **JAPANESE** ANCESTRY

Living in the Following Area:

All that portion of the County of Pierce, State of Washington, east of a line running generally north and south, beginning at the point at which the King-Pierce County line intersects the easterly limits of the City of Tacoma; thence southerly and following the easterly limits of said city to Washington State Highway No. 5: thence southerly along said Highway No. 5 to Pierce-Thurston County line

Pursuant to the provisions of Civilian Exclusion Order No. 58, this Headquarters, dated May 10, 1942, all persons of Japanese ancestry, both alien and non-alien, will be evacuated from the above area by 12 o'clock noon, P. W. T., Saturday, May 16, 1942.

No Japanese person living in the above area will be permitted to change residence after 12 o'clock noon, P. W. T., Sunday, May 10, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the representative of the Commanding Gen-eral, Northwestern Sector, at the Civil Control Station located at:

City Hall Auditorium, Puyallup, Washington

Such permits will only be granted for the purpose of uniting members of a family, or in cases of grave emergency, The Civil Control Station is equipped to assist the Japanese population affected by this evacuation in the fol-


- 1. Give advice and instructions on the evacuation.
- Provide services with respect to the management, leasing, sale, storage or other disposition of most kinds of property, such as real estate, business and professional equipment, household goods, boats, automobiles and livestock.
- 3. Provide temporary residence elsewhere for all Japanese in family groups.
- 4. Transport persons and a limited amount of clothing and equipment to their new residence.

The Following Instructions Must Be Observed:

- A responsible member of each family, preferably the head of the family, or the person in whose name most of the property is held, and each individual living alone, will report to the Civil Control Station to receive further instructions. This must be done between 380 A. M. and 5500 P. M. on Monday, May 11, 1942. A. M. and 5:00 P. M. on Tuesday, May 12, 1942.
- 2. Evacuees must carry with them on departure for the Assembly Center, the following property:
- (a) Bedding and linens (no mattress) for each member of the family;
- (b) Toilet articles for each member of the family; (c) Extra clothing for each member of the family:
- (d) Essential personal effects for each member of the family
- All items carried will be securely packaged, tied and plainly marked with the name of the owner and numbered in accordance with instructions obtained at the Civil Control Station. The size and number of packages is limited to that which can be carried by the individual or family group.
- 3. No pets of any kind will be permitted.
- 4. No personal items and no household goods will be shipped to the Assembly Center.

5. The United States Government through its agencies will provide for the storage, at the sole risk of the owner, of the more substantial household items, such as iceboxes, washing machines, pianos and other heavy furniture. Cooking utensils and other small items will be accepted for storage if crated, packed and pl name and address of the owner. Only one name and address will be used by a given family.

Each family, and individual living alone, will be furnished transportation to the Assauthorized to travel by private automobile in a supervised group. All instructions pertaining






TRAIL OF TEARS **CHEROKEE**

"Walk in their Footsteps"

The area surrounding the Cedartown Big Spring was first inhabited by the Cherokee Indians. The land was prized for its abundance of sparkling spring water and shade-providing cedar trees. The Cherokee people lived here peacefully until May 26, 1838 when militiamen began their forced round up as part of the 1830 Indian Removal Act. Eighty soldiers set up a military post here, on this very land, creating Camp Cedar Town. More than 200 Cherokeemen, women, and children-were captured during a month's time, Soldiers used the camp as a place to hold the Cherokee captive until they were forced to travel to deportation camps in Tennessee and later, farther west. Because of this, the land where you now stand plays a significant role in the Trail of Tears. On this ground, the Cherokee people wept, mourning the loss of the land they loved and the lives lost along this trail paved with tears.





JOINT STATEMENT REGARDING USE OF RACE OR ETHNICITY IN AAPA PRESENTATIONS, 2023

The AAPA Commission for Continuing Professional Development and Education and the AAPA Commission on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion recognize the harmful effects of misrepresenting race or ethnicity as biology. Race is a social construct and is distinct from ethnicity, genetic ancestry, or biology. AAPA supports eliminating patterns or conceptualizations of race or ethnicity as a proxy for biology or genetics in medical education, clinical practice, and policy.



American Medical Association 2020

AMA encourages characterizing race as a social construct, rather than an inherent biological trait, and recognizes that when race is described as a risk factor, it is more likely to be a proxy for influences including structural racism than a proxy for genetics.
