

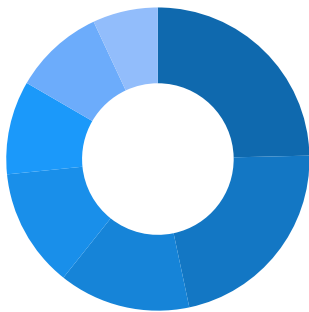

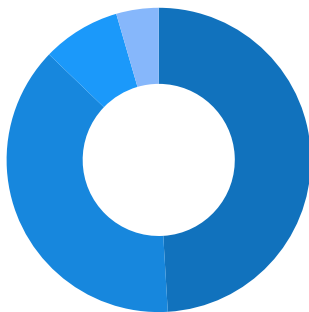
## Percent of PAs by Specialty in Virginia



- 23.7% Surgical Subspecialties
- 21.2% All Other Specialties
- 13.5% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 12.2% Emergency Medicine
- 9.6% Family Medicine
- 9.3% Urgent Care
- 6.7% General Peds, General Internal Med

16.3% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

## Percent of PAs by Setting in Virginia



- 49% Physician Office or clinic
- 38.1% Hospital Settings
- 8.3% Urgent Care Center
- 4.5% Other Settings

55.8% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

## In Virginia

- ▣ 31.5% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 69 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 48 hours per month
