- 29.1% Surgical subspecialties
- 24.0% All other specialties

- 10.2% Family medicine

- 6.2% General peds, general IM

Percent of PAs by Setting in Virginia



- 52.9% Physician office or clinic
- 34.2% Hospital settings
- 7.2% Urgent care center
- 5.7% Other settings

In Virginia:

- A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 52 hours per month
