


Percent of PAs by Specialty in Texas



- 26.1% All Other Specialties
- 24.9% Surgical Subspecialties
- 15.5% Family Medicine
- 13.9% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 6.4% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.6% Emergency Medicine
- 4.2% Urgent Care

22% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

Percent of PAs by Setting in Texas



- 59.7% Physician Office or clinic
- 30.5% Hospital Settings
- 6.2% Other Settings
- 3.6% Urgent Care Center

51.4% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Texas

- 24.6% of PAs serve in rural areas
- A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- A typical PA is on call 36 hours per month
