

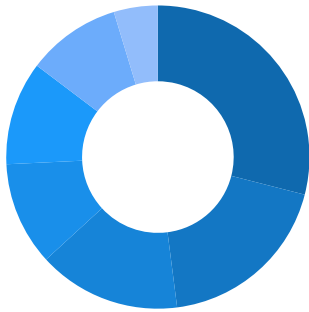

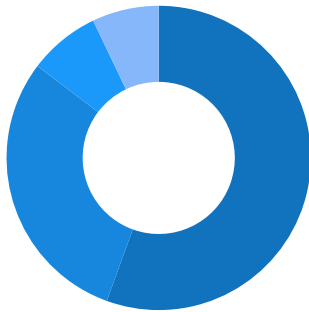
## Percent of PAs by Specialty in Tennessee



- 27.8% Surgical Subspecialties
- 18.2% All Other Specialties
- 14.6% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 10.6% Urgent Care
- 10.6% Family Medicine
- 9.6% Emergency Medicine
- 4.5% General Peds, General Internal Med

15.2% of PAs specialize in Primary Care

## Percent of PAs by Setting in Tennessee



- 55.6% Physician Office or clinic
- 29.8% Hospital Settings
- 7.6% Other Settings
- 7.1% Urgent Care Center

51% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

## In Tennessee

- ▣ A typical PA completes 65 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 24 hours per month
- ▣ 72.9% of Tennessee PAs would choose their career over again
