- 53.6% Physician office or clinic
- 30.6% Hospital settings

In Tennessee:

- ▶ 14% of Tennessee PAs serve in rural areas
- ▶ A typical PA completes 60 patient visits per week
- ▶ A typical PA is on call 50 hours per month
