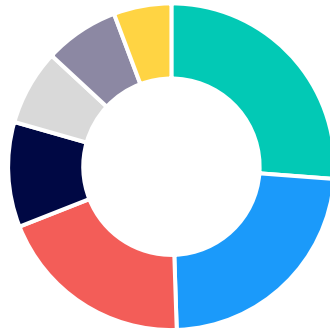

- 58.2% Physician office or clinic
- 28.0% Hospital settings
