
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# How Do I Get Into Academia?

- Second, Ask Yourself an Important Question?
  - Why Do You Want to Teach?
  - Then...
    - Can you articulate "why" in an Elevator Pitch?
    - Can you compose "why" in a Teaching Philosophy?
- Third, Reach out to a PA Program about opportunities to contribute as:
  - Clinical Preceptor
  - Guest Lecturer
  - Facilitate Case-Based Learning (PBL)
  - Admissions/Interviews
  - Grading Clinical Skills/OSCEs
  - Submit Abstracts for Local/State/National Professional Organization Meetings

  - PAEA Job Posting Board
  - Chronicles of Higher Education
  - Insider Higher Education
  - University Websites
- How to apply and boost your CV?
  - Include any Experience
    - Teaching Classroom or Clinical Precepting?
    - Service Clinical or Professional Organization Committees?
    - Publications Prior Research or Clinical Topics?
    - Presentations Local/State/National Meetings?
  - Write a Good Cover Letter
  - Consider Including Teaching Philosophy
  - Patience through Process
