



Tell a story. The nccPA Health Foundation's interprofessional video series encourages PAs to *learn* about oral health, connect oral health to overall health, collaborate with the care team, and educate patients for better self-care.

Use the Qualis Health **Oral Health Delivery Framework** to start integrating oral health with just five steps.

ASK LOOK about oral health risk factors and for signs that indicate oral symptoms of health risk or oral disease disease

DECIDE on the most appropriate response

ACT offer preventive interventions and/or referral
