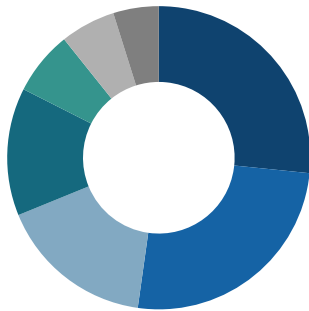

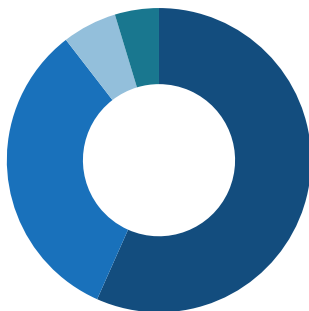
Percent of PAs by Specialty in Texas



- 25.8% All Other Specialties
- 24.8% Surgical Subspecialties
- 16.1% Family Medicine
- 13.2% Internal Medicine Subspecialties
- 6.6% Emergency Medicine
- 5.7% General Peds, General Internal Med
- 4.7% Urgent Care

21.9% of PAs specialize in Primary Care (Primary Care includes Family Medicine [with and without Urgent Care], General Internal Medicine, and General Pediatrics)

Percent of PAs by Setting in Texas



- 55.7% Physician Office or Clinic
- 32.3% Hospital Settings
- 5.7% Other Settings
- 4.6% Urgent Care Center

47.8% of PAs are employed by a Physician Group or Solo Practice

In Texas

- ▣ 25.8% of PAs serve in rural areas
- ▣ A typical PA completes 70.5 patient visits per week
- ▣ A typical PA is on call 40 hours per month
